

FORM DFS-F2-SI-17 SPLIT POINT CHANGE FOR EXCESS/NON-EXCESS CLAIM REPORTING

Pursuant to the workers' compensation rate change filed by the National Council on Compensation Insurance and approved by the Department of Financial Services to be effective 1/1/2024, the split point for reporting excess and non-excess claims changed from \$18,500 to \$18,000 for loss data used in the calculation of experience modifications effective on or after 1/1/2024.

Please note that this change applies to those Form DFS-F2-SI-17 filings with an evaluation date of 1/1/2024 or after. Any outstanding Form DFS-F2-SI-17 filings with evaluation dates prior to 1/1/2024 should continue to use the \$18,500 split point.

Accordingly, please ensure that claims for $\underline{\text{all}}$ loss periods listed on the electronic Self-Insurer Unit Statistical Report (Form DFS-F2-SI-17) spreadsheet are separated between excess (greater than appropriate split point) and non-excess (less than or equal to the appropriate split point) at the correct incurred (indemnity + medical only) amount.
